



about 1-1/4 inch long; connexivum pale




Triatoma recurva

about 1-1/8 inch long; connexivum yellow banded




Triatoma gerstaeckeri

less than 1 inch long




first femur with thick hair




Triatoma lecticularius


first antennal segment long ← first femur with sparse hair → first antennal segment short



Triatoma rubida




eyes large




Triatoma sanguisuga
